3 Tips to Protect Your Roof This Winter

1. In the N.W. moss and algae build up are common place but what is not widely known is that moss roots into the shingles and causes early failure of most types of composite roofing. It also traps water for longer periods and can contribute to mold and rot issues. So removal and regular treatment is highly recommended in those trouble areas of your roof.

2. Most roof sealants tend to last about 5 years on average. Under most re-roof conditions more sealants are used then a tear-off project thus re-roofs generally require more servicing then new tear-off roofs require. So it is a good rule of thumb to have your roof looked over every 5 years at a maximum and more often as

the roof nears the end of its useful or aesthetic life.

3. Keep gutters and drains clear of debris. Gutters that are full of debris and do not properly drain tend to cause wood rot along the bottom edges of your roof. This can lead to future repairs that can be costly when it comes time to have a new roof installed. On flat roofs it can cause a build-up of pressure thus causing water to find its way into your home where under normal conditions and clear drains it would not.

Be prepared and don't wait until the buckets are out to get your roof serviced.
